When using the auto size mode the images will resize continuously

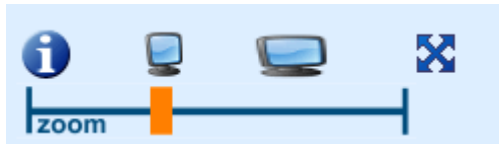
If there is no change in presentation the talking head will increase

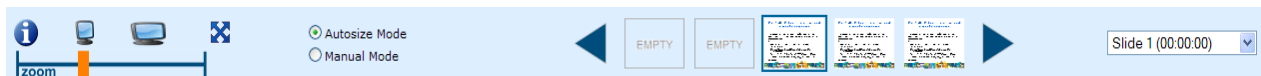

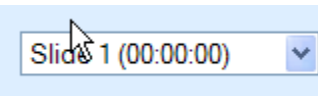

With this button you can jump directly to the slide witch you want to see and the video will begin from that point.



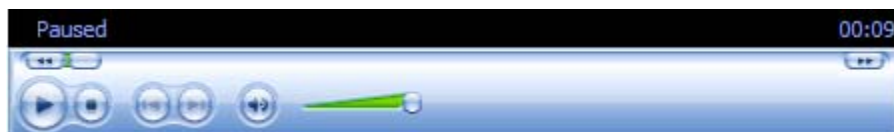
