50 000 people die from **malnutrition** everyday.



- Need: 70% > food than available today
- **From** national security & commercial competition
- **To** world security & international collaboration

Effective action requires data



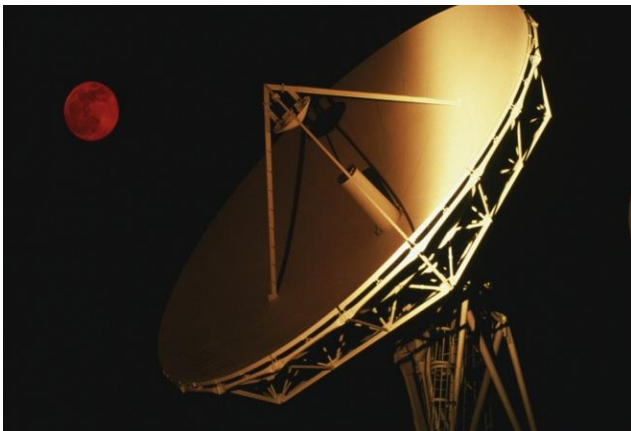
- **Farming** = 37% methane emissions
- **Increase productivity**
 - Water
 - Fertilizers
 - Improved inputs
 - Disease resistant crops
- **Maximize ODA impact** / avoid duplication

Data that anyone can **access**, **use** and **share**:

- Readily available to everyone
- Reliable
- Useful
- Has best practices, success stories

Responding to food security challenges ahead

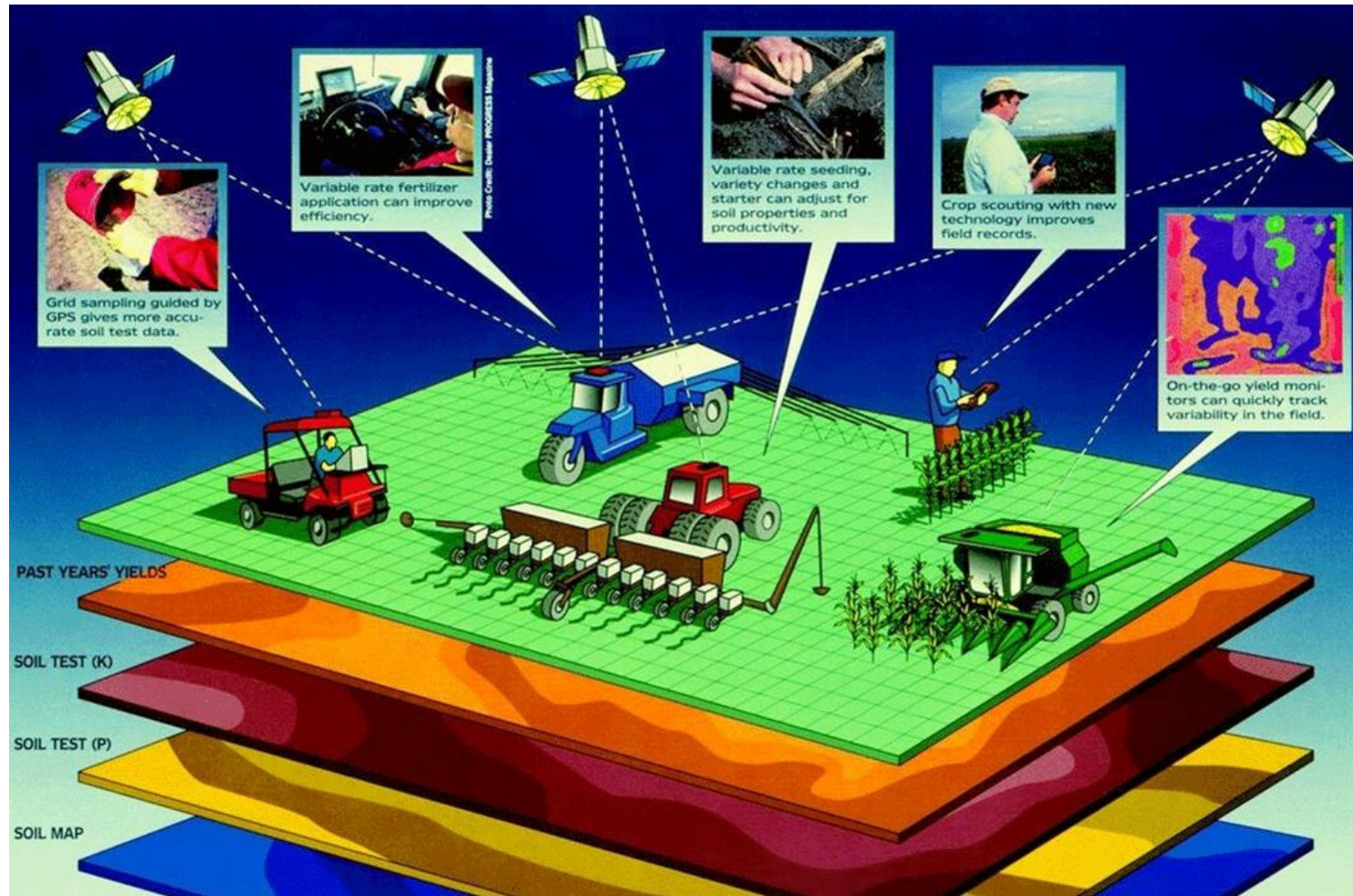
- **Mitigation:**

Preventing / forecasting climatic catastrophes

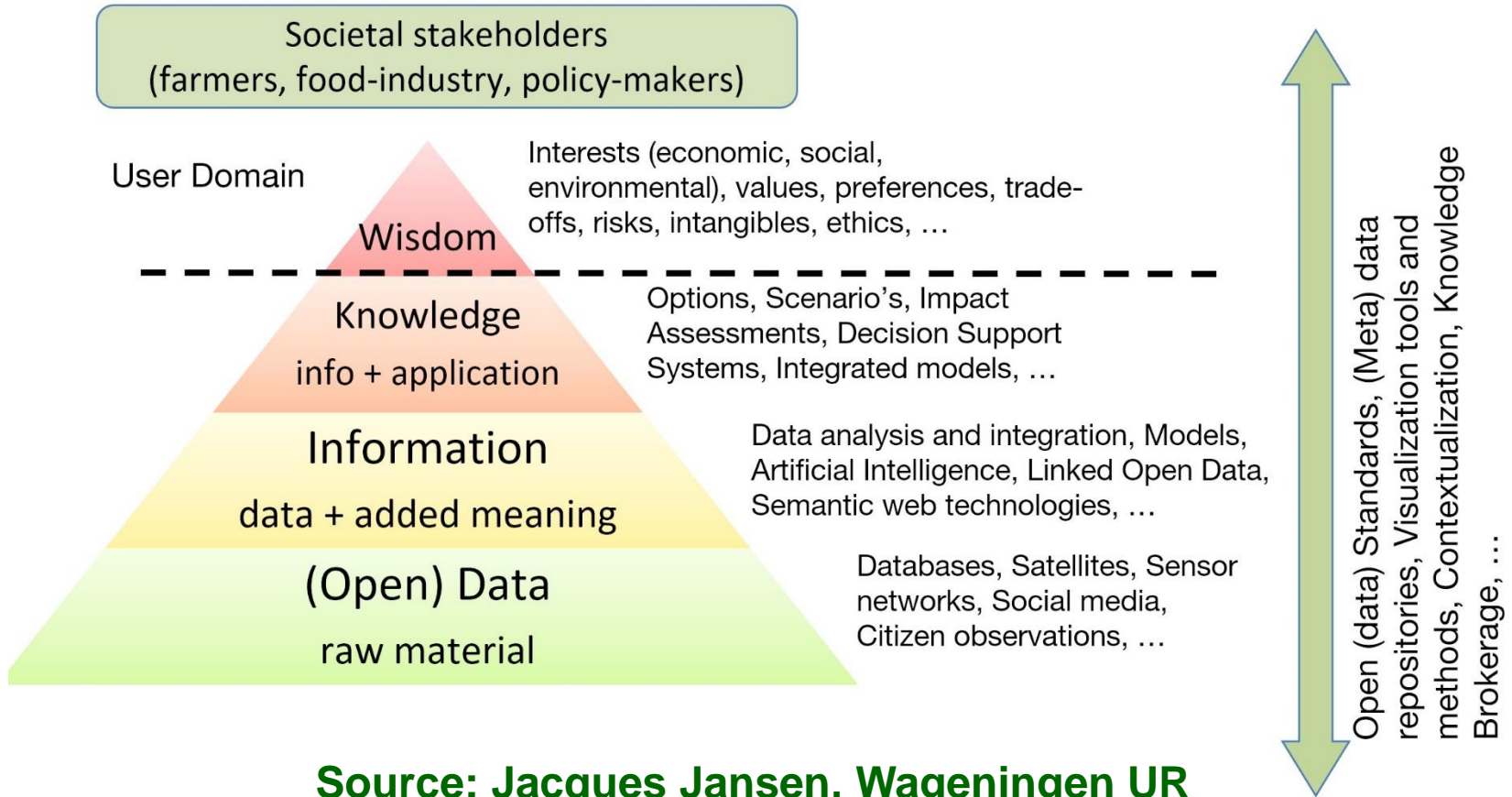
- **Adaptation:**
